

**Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW)
with Substance Abuse Treatment Specialty (CSAC)**

Ho`ōla Lāhui Hawai`i is a FQHC, non-profit community health organization serving families throughout the county of Kaua'i. We are seeking a full-time LCSW-CSAC for our community health center.

Under the supervision of the Behavioral Health Director, our LCSW-CSAC counsels and aids individuals and families requiring assistance dealing with behavioral health (BH) concerns including substance abuse problems.

Position Description

- Completes BH evaluations, confers with other professionals, makes treatment recommendations, determines available treatment options and delivers empirically based outpatient treatment when appropriate.
- Treatment to include counseling clients individually, in group sessions, and with their families to assist client in overcoming BH and/or substance related problems.
- Coordinates care with relevant Ho`ōla providers and community agencies in the ongoing assessment and treatment of patients with behavioral health and substance abuse problems.
- Develops appropriate protocols, treatment programs, policies and procedures within Ho`ōla departments that support the organization's mission.
- Monitors conditions of patients, using BH measurements, to evaluate success of treatment outcome. Continues to make treatment adjustments based on this feedback.
- Serves as liaison for Ho`ōla in substance abuse coalitions and community groups.
- Acts in accordance with professional ethics guidelines and Ho`ōla policies to include but not be limited to empirically based treatment approaches and documentation.

Requirements

- Currently licensed as Social Worker in state of Hawaii and Certified Substance Abuse Counselor.
- Demonstrates the required level of knowledge and skill integration for high level of practice.
- Able to communicate clearly and tactfully with others, prepare written reports and other necessary communications in a professional manner.
- Minimum 1 year experience and Certified Substance Abuse Counselor (CSAC).
- Knowledge of Hawaiian culture and other ethnic cultures.
- Knowledge of community and agency resources.
